


Sets Include: 4 divider strips 24 inches long (610mm) and 16 holders with self-stick tape (1"H (25mm) set contains 20 holders)



1. Using a tape measure, measure and mark the front or back of your drawer, box, etc. where you would like your first divider to start at.

Dividers can be cut and installed to meet your needs. The following instructions are an example to guide you through the layout process using the 3"H set.



2. Measure the opposite end (in this case the front) of the drawer and make a mark at the same distance from the drawer side as you did the back mark.



3. Take one of the holders and peel away the adhesive backing.





4. Press the holder onto the mark at the back of the drawer.




Peel the adhesive backing on another holder and press it the mark at the front of the drawer.




6. Measure the distance from the center of the back holder to the center of the front holder.



7. Mark one of your dividers. Using the 1859-01 cutting template and 1860-01 retractable knife, score the divider 3 to 4 times at the mark.



8. Position your hands on either side of the score.



9. With hands in position, snap the divider.



Slide the divider between the front and back holders.



11. Decide the position you would like your next divider. This divider is going to be side to side. Measure and mark the the side of the first divider where the next holder will be. Peel away another holder's adhesive and press it onto the mark.



12. Measure from the front of the drawer to the back of the holder to determine the location to place the holder at on the right side of the drawer.



13. At the right side of the drawer, measure and mark the drawer at the same place that the last holder was placed in step 13.



14. Peel the adhesive backing from the holder and press the holder onto the new mark.



15. Measure the distance from the center of one holder to the center of the other.



 Measure and cut a divider to the correct measured size and slide it between the two holders.



17. Continue adding dividers to meet your needs. Organize our supplies.
